It is time for another prayer focus for the City of Corpus Christi. Our focus for January 2005 will be to ask the Lord to deal with the work of a Lying Spirit (1Kings 22:22) in our area and to send forth the Spirit of Truth (John 15:26) to be manifested among us.

As we continue to pray concerning these negative spiritual influences, or as some might call them strongholds, please do not think that we believe this is the only prayer concern for the city. Nor do we think that we are people who have some special authority to call the city to prayer. Rather, we at SPMI believe that these negative spiritual influences and what we refer to as the opposite spirits, which are godly spiritual influences, are things that the Lord desires to deal with at this time. We send the information out generally because we believe it is the Lord's will.

Some people have trouble with the thought of ministering spirits, but that is largely because of our Western mindsets that tend to deny any supernatural things at all. (See Hebrews 1:14) Remember that angels strengthened Jesus. (See Luke 22:43) Let us not be fearful of the things of God, of the working of the Holy Spirit. Let us look to Jesus expecting great things this next year.
