Dear Believer:

As we move forward diligence is necessary to not give place to the devil by harsh words of anger, gossip, or slander that hinder our growth. Let us submit to God, lay aside every sin and weight that slows us down in our maturity and run forward as fast as we can into the wonderful things our Father has planned for us. We are indeed one in the Spirit. One Spirit has baptized us into Christ and the only real option is to grow up into the fullness of the stature of Christ. One church, one faith, one bread, one baptism, one Father who is above all, in all and through us all.

Praise the Lord for all that He is doing in this city to bring glory to His great name.

Pray that God continue to advance the kingdom by blending the leadership of this city into a cohesive unit.

Pray that the Lord will bring together the intercessory ministry into the same kind of cohesive unit.

Pray for the cutting off of a spirit of assassination which is out to slander and destroy believers.

Pray for the Lord to pour out a Spirit of Repentance, a Spirit of Holiness, a Spirit of Love.
