Dear Believer:

Recently the Lord gave me an example of living in the kingdom of God. When Jesus went from Judea to Galilee he was walking in the kingdom, but the people right beside him were walking in the Roman Empire. It is not a matter of perspective, but understanding. Imagine what people with no kingdom understanding saw when Moses went to hold a stick in the air during a war. To walk in the purposes of God we must know the will of God. At the Monthly Pastors' Prayer Breakfast in May the question arose: What do we believe is the will of God? These were the answers and prayers that have been formulated from them.

- 1. God wants us to have a Kingdom perspective. Lord, let us see the kingdom.
- 2. God wants Christ revealed; without revelation of Christ the people perish. Father, reveal Christ through our lives.
- 3. The church must constantly reflect Jesus as Lord, King and Priest now and we must be rulers and worshipers now. Father, may we live lives that show Jesus as King and Lord of all.
- 4. We must understand that difficult times are coming so we may be in readiness, living in expectation of His return. Lord, give us understanding of the times and seasons that we may look up for our redemption which is drawing near.
- 5. God wants us to listen to Him. He is giving us an ear. Jesus, grant us hearts tuned to the will of God.
- 6. We must recognize that we are Servants. We must walk as servants, in lowliness of heart. **Pray we live in true humility.**
- 7. Perfection in unity and growth in love recognizing His invitation to intimacy with Him and each other through repentance. Lord, reveal all areas where we fall short of Your desire for us.
- 8. A proper perspective of the King and His reign. Father, open our eyes to truly see Jesus in His glory.
- 9. Do not be distracted by circumstances; His rule is happening now. Jesus, may we stay focused on You.
- 10. We must understand God is de-secularizing the church. Father, reveal where we are ruled by worldly systems.
- 11. We must serve the coming revival. Let's serve what He is doing, not what we are doing. **Holy Spirit, consume us so** that we are able to see and serve what the Father is doing in every place.
- 12. God desires us to live seeing God. Holy Spirit, open our eyes to see Jesus in every situation of each person's life.
- 13. God is giving the Church unprecedented access and authority and we should walk in it. Jesus, grant that we know when God is giving us favor and access so that we do not miss kingdom opportunities.
- 14. God desires proper responses. Pray that we no longer be a reactive church, but a responsive and proactive people.
- 15. He wants us hearing what our Father is saying, seeing what our Father is doing, being functionally united. Holy Spirit, open our eyes to understand the absolute unity of the Body of Christ; when one suffers, all suffer; when one rejoices, all rejoice.
- 16. We should always be Shepherds who are giving their lives for the sheep. Pray that we have the mind of Christ indeed and be those who are willing to serve others even unto death so that they might live.

As we lift these prayers for our leaders and ourselves, may God awaken us to all He is doing in these latter days. May we proclaim His goodness and glory to all who do not yet understand. It is not a matter of lifestyle preferences, but eternal life for each and every person. **Lord, grant that all see and know your glory.**
